

MatDeck - Work with SQLite database

Connecting to SQLite database

- Level: Basic

This example shows how to connect to a SQLite database using MatDeck. SQLite databases come pre-installed so users can concentrate on their practice instead of toying with installation commands. We will use the `db_connect()` function to establish a connection to database. The function `db_connect()` is a universal function that can be used for all sorts of DB connections, you can use it to connect to the following databases: SQLite, MySQL, MSSQL and PostgreSQL.

Connecting a to Database using the `db_connect()` function

Here we will show how to connect to a database with a given name, and to print the connection object as proof.

```
DatVal := "sqlite_database.db" Connection Parameters
```

```
 Connecting To The Server
```

```
conn := db_connect("sqlite", "Name", "", 0, "", "", DatVal)
```

```
conn = object of type sql Value Of conn Variable
```

```
db_close(conn) Disconnecting From The Server
```

We could also achieve this task using MatDeck script inside the document.
